1. Background

GOAL Haiti is implementing a portfolio of projects with Department of State (DoS), Irish Aid (IA), United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA), and United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) funding across Ouest, Grand'Anse and Sud departments of Haiti.

To ensure the quality and effectiveness of programme monitoring, reporting and learning systems, GOAL Haiti are seeking the support of an experienced MEAL Consultant for a two-month contract, working to deliver the objective and deliverables detailed below.

2. Objective of the Assignment

The primary objective of this assignment is to support GOAL Haiti's MEAL team to kick off and close out several projects while also managing the analysis and report writing of a needs assessment, mainstreaming capacity building of GOAL Haiti MEAL staff throughout.

3. Key Responsibilities and Deliverables

The MEAL Consultant will be responsible for the following deliverables within the 2-month assignment period:

A. ECHO Needs Assessment

- 1. Clean and analyse data collected by GOAL and its project proposal partner for an upcoming ECHO HIP proposal.
- 2. Produce a needs assessment report which clearly identifies needs, gaps in services and community priorities based on data collected.

B. DoS Endline Assessments

- 3. Following the MEAL plan, support GOAL Haiti's MEAL team to prepare data collection tools for Food Security and WASH endline assessments.
- 4. Support GOAL Haiti's MEAL team to analyse data collected and produce endline reports which clearly communicate findings, analyse results and conclude on causes as well as producing recommendations for programmatic learning.

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C. UNICEF Endline Assessment

- 5. Following the MEAL plan, support GOAL Haiti's MEAL team to prepare data collection tools for a Nutrition endline assessment
- 6. Support GOAL Haiti's MEAL team to analyse data collected and produce endline reports which clearly communicate findings, analyse results and conclude on causes as well as producing recommendations for programmatic learning.

D. OCHA MEAL Planning

- 7. Lead the MEAL planning of GOAL Haiti's OCHA project, including finalizing the MEL Workbook and developing data collection tools.
- 8. Share and communicate the project MEAL planning to GOAL Haiti's MEAL team.

E. Mainstream Capacity Building

9. Throughout the above, mainstream capacity building into all work through explaining work to GOAL Haiti MEAL team through meetings and one-to-one coaching.
